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



Patients with High Dose Chronic Opioid Prescriptions


Opioid Prescriptions (>90 MME/day) by Quarter, Kitsap County & Washington State, 2012-2017




Self-Reported Drug Use Among Kitsap Youth, 2016






Kitsap Youth Self-Reported Beliefs About Prescription Drugs in Kitsap, 2016



Number of Syringes Exchanged, Kitsap, 2002-2018





Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome (NAS), Count of Cases and Rate, Kitsap County, 2013 to 2017^ (4)





Hospitalization Rates (Nonfatal), Kitsap County and Washington State, 2000 to 2017^




Hospitalization Rates (Nonfatal), Kitsap County and Washington State, 2003-07 to 2013-17^


Fatal Opioid Overdoses


Fatal Prescription Opioid Overdoses


Fatal Heroin Overdoses


Death Rates, Kitsap County and Washington State, 2003-07 to 2013-17^




Treatment for OUD Involving Heroin

Number of Buprenorphine Waivered Providers per 1,000 Medicaid Enrollees Diagnosed with OUD*, 2018 Q2





Progress in Kitsap County

- Medication Assisted Treatment access significantly expanded
- Major medical systems participating in program to improve pain management, decrease unsafe levels of opioid prescribing
- Naloxone is more available for overdose reversal
 - First responders in Kitsap carry naloxone
 - Mobile syringe exchange provides naloxone
 - Public naloxone trainings
