Kitsap Public Health District proposing fee adjustments

Public information meeting scheduled on January 21

KITSAP COUNTY, WA— The Kitsap Public Health District is holding a public meeting to answer questions and take comments on proposed fee adjustments for its Food & Living Environment Program. The meeting is on Thursday, January 21 from 7 – 8 p.m. in the Chambers of the Norm Dicks Government Center at 345 6th St. in Bremerton.

The proposed fee adjustments for its Food & Living Environment Program cover:

- **Food service establishments** (i.e., restaurants, grocery stores, taverns/bars, caterers, school kitchens, mobile food operations, temporary food events, etc.);
- **Public pools** (i.e., water recreation facilities that are not part of a single-family dwelling or residential duplex dwelling owned by the residents);
- **Camps** (i.e., organizational group camps where living facilities, food service, and lodging are provided) ; and
- **Schools** (e.g., central kitchens and warming kitchens).
