Kitsap Public Health Board to meet Tues., Nov. 1

Board to consider new regulations for a secure medicine return program

KITSAP COUNTY, WA— During their monthly meeting on Tues., Nov. 1, the Kitsap Public Health Board will review and discuss proposed secure medicine return regulations that would:

- Provide drop-off locations for unused medications throughout Kitsap County;
- Provide an option for residents to dispose of unused medicine by mail at no charge;
- Require the pharmaceutical industry pay for these programs.

The meeting is scheduled on Tues., Nov. 1, 2016, from 1:45 – 3 p.m. in the Norm Dicks Government Center Chambers, 345 6th Street in Bremerton.
