If you've already submitted your driver's license, proof of insurance, and registration, you can use a form like this to arrange for vouchers for Medicaid-covered medical appointments that have been scheduled up to one month ahead of time.

Or, if you have access to a computer, once you are established in their system, the requests can be made online by going to www.wanemt.com, hovering over the "Home" tab then selecting "Trip Booking Wizard" and completing the screening questions and request form. The 2 business day rule still applies.
