

APPLICATION TO PREPARE BAKED GOODS IN A RESIDENTIAL KITCHEN

Baked goods sold or served to the public may be prepared in a residential home kitchen only if ALL the following criteria are met:

- The baked goods are non-potentially hazardous such as cookies, cakes, breads.
- The items are individually wrapped.
- The items are for sale by a **religious, charitable, or educational organization**.
- A sign is posted at the sale location stating that “These foods are prepared in a kitchen that is not inspected by the Kitsap Public Health District.”

Please answer each question below to find out if you meet all the criteria listed above and submit to the Health District along with your application for the temporary event.

APPLICATION QUESTIONNAIRE

1. Baked goods you are serving must be non-potentially hazardous. List baked goods to be sold or served. Please note: Pumpkin, cream, and custard pies are considered potentially hazardous and must meet requirements for complex menu items.

2. The baked goods you are serving must be individually wrapped in a sanitary manner with no bare hand contact. How are you going to package or wrap them?

3. Is your organization religious (), charitable (), or educational ()? Please check one that applies. What is the name of your organization?

Briefly state the purpose of your organization.

4. There must be a sign at the site to let consumers know that the baked goods have been prepared in a kitchen that is not subject to regulation and inspection by the Health Department. Can you meet this requirement?
