

AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT 2170

This Amendment (“Amendment”) to Kitsap Public Health District Contract 2170 for FEMA MASS VAX (the “Contract”), is entered into between the Peninsula Community Health Services (“Contractor”) and the Kitsap Public Health District (“District”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on February 29, 2020, the Governor of Washington State executed a Proclamation of Emergency relating to the COVID-19 outbreak, which remains in effect;

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared the rapidly spreading COVID-19 a pandemic;

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States issued a Proclamation declaring COVID-19 a nation emergency, which remains in effect;

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into the Contract effective May 20, 2021; and

WHEREAS, President Biden has announced an extension of 100 percent federal reimbursement for eligible COVID-19 emergency response costs through June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, The DOH FEMA COVID-19 Vaccination Project that details the Implementation of a state supported, regionally coordinated, and locally synchronized COVID-19 vaccination effort from October 1, 2020 to July 1, 2022 is extended until September 30, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

I. Amendment of Contract Section 1 Period of Performance.

The period of performance of this Agreement shall begin January 21, 2021 (“effective date”) and be completed no later than September 30, 2022, unless terminated sooner or extended as provided for herein.

II. Effective Date. This Amendment is effective upon signature of both parties.


III. Authorization. Each party signing below warrants to the other party that they have the full power and authority to execute this Amendment on behalf of the party for whom they sign.
