The Kitsap Public Health Board needs your voice

- Under a new state law, local health boards must include both elected officials and nonelected community representatives, beginning in mid-2022.
- **The Kitsap Public Health Board is seeking applicants to fill three nonelected positions.**
- This is a unique opportunity to help shape health priorities and policies in your community.

What does the Health Board do?

- The Kitsap Public Health Board addresses issues affecting the health of all people in Kitsap County.
- The Health Board is the governing body for the Kitsap Public Health District.
- The Health Board and Health District serve unincorporated Kitsap County and the four incorporated Kitsap cities (Bainbridge Island, Bremerton, Port Orchard, and Poulsbo).

CURRENT BOARD STRUCTURE

Seven-member board. Meets monthly.

3 Kitsap County Commissioners
(elected officials)



4 City Mayors or Councilpersons
(elected officials)



NEW BOARD STRUCTURE

Ten-member board. Meets monthly.

1 Kitsap County Commissioner
(elected official)



4 City Mayors or Councilpersons
(elected officials)

2 Tribal Representatives
(appointed by American Indian Health Commission)



3 Nonelected Members
(appointed by Board of County Commissioners)



Who can serve in a nonelected position?

Per state law, the nonelected positions must be filled by Kitsap County residents representing these three categories:

- **Healthcare and public health professionals**
- **Consumers of public health services**
(residents who have experienced inequities and have lived experience with public health services)
- **Other community stakeholders**
(includes representatives of organizations serving populations experiencing health inequities, current or former armed forces members, the business community, environmental health-regulated groups)
