


A YEAR OF HOPE



196,271

Kitsap residents have received at least one dose of vaccine.



72% of all Kitsap residents have received at least one dose of vaccine.



65% of all Kitsap residents have completed their primary vaccine series.



59,334 Have received a booster dose or third dose.

Medical Reserve Corps volunteers dedicated more than **17,000 hours** in support of vaccination sites in Kitsap.


KITSAP PUBLIC HEALTH VACCINATION PROGRAM



Kitsap Public Health District, in partnership with the Kitsap County Emergency Operations Center and many other entities, has operated vaccination clinics, provided logistical support, supplies, and guidance to other vaccinators, promoted vaccination in all areas of the county, and tracked and shared vaccination data.
