

## Confirmation or Denial of Service Kitsap County Coordinated Utilities Water Plan

Written confirmation or denial of service including remote opportunities for a proposed development is required, in accordance with Kitsap County Resolution 305-1993, *Coordinated Water System Plan* and Kitsap County Ordinance 134, from the existing water utility or qualified Satellite Management Agency (SMA) before a new water system can be developed. This form must be completed by the water purveyor, operations manager, water commissioner, or SMA and returned to the applicant within 30 days of receiving this request.
